TTHUF's first recipient of bra and breast prosthesis sponsorship project in Trinidad & Tobago

The Trinidad and Tobago Healthcare United Kingdom Forum (TTHUF) announces that it has completed its first sponsorship of the Angel Bra and Nubian Skin breast softie prosthesis to a breast cancer survivor in Trinidad and Tobago.

TTHUF has a Memorandum of Understanding with Mrs Ora Gordon who is an Angel Bra specialist and agent in Trinidad and Tobago. This collaboration was fostered when it was recognised that many women in T&T do not have access to a proper fitting bra and appropriate breast prosthesis following breast surgery.

The Board of Trustees agreed a qualifying process for identifying women who would benefit from the sponsorship programme. Two women were identified earlier this year; one on each island.

The first recipient, Donna Sydney-Murray, was diagnosed with Stage 3 breast cancer in October 2021. She had a left mastectomy in November 2021. On 27th August, Donna was presented with two Angel bras and 2 softie breast prostheses. Her appreciation was expressed in a video and photos taken at the time of the presentation.

The Board of Trustees has agreed that it would sponsor an additional two women before the end of this year.
